by Survey bearing Date the Twenty Seeth day of January one Thousand
seven hundred and Eighty seven lying and being in the county of Albemarle
in both Sides of Maphers Road and on Waters of Bush Island Creek and
bounded as followeth To wit Beginning at a Pine Thomas Piddys corner
Thence on his line South twenty two Degrees East twenty two poles to
Hendersons Branch same course continued One hundred and twenty
